What a busy spring we have all had. Below you will find notes from our last three Divan meetings so read on and find out what has been happening. Please drive by the Shrine Center and check out our new sign. It looks fantastic!! Also, lots of updates on our website so check them out too!

Susanne, Financial Secretary

Erica Young from Chicken Creek Communications presented a thorough visual and audio presentation on the new Naja Web Site.

Dennis Thompson reported 6 van trips, 4 airlines, and 28 patients treated for January. He stated that NAJA was now treating 553 patients. He then reported that the annual hospital days would be May 15 & 16 with a hospital visit and Twins game. The temple would pay for the transportation and motel.

The event will be moved to March to avoid scheduling conflicts. They also will be adding a chili cook-off and other fun events to go along with the day.

A motion was approved for the Air Patrol for approximately \$1500 for 4 new tables to set the cotton candy machines on and that can also be used for selling tables.

The Hospital Division Report for December was given by Hospital Representative, Jim Hopkins: 3 van trips, 2 airline tickets purchased, 23 patients assisted, 553 total patients.

Potentate Stirling discussed an issue we have with raffles; that all raffles must be approved 30 days in advance by the Secretary of State.


