

## ***Naja Kids Camps***

### ***A Summer of Friends & Fun***



What childhood memories do you have of the summer: Camping with your family, playing with friends, fishing, or hiking? Maybe those memories are all just a feeling... a feeling of having fun. This year Naja helped to build on those memories with our patients at the Naja Patient Kids Camps.

The first camp was held at the end of July and marked the first overnight camp of the program. Naja partnered with Meeting the Need, an organization whose goal is to provide a handicap accessible camping experience in the Black Hills. Their facility, located near Keystone, SD, was the perfect venue for this camp. The kids participated in all the fun of over-night camping experiences, roasting marshmallows, sitting around campfires, cookouts, and movies under the stars. They explored a fully accessible tin mine (many had never been in a mine or cave), fished, hiked, rode ATVs, had a scavenger, hunt and did numerous arts and crafts. The kids also were able to have breakfast with the birds, through a visit from the Black Hills Raptor Center. At the end of the camp, many kids wanted to stay longer, and patients were appreciative of a weekend where their kids could just be kids.

The second camp was held in Hot Springs, SD, at the Hidden Lake Campground. This is the second year the camp has been held at this location. The kids enjoyed fishing, boating, photography, nature walk, swimming, arts and crafts and our famous Shriner Patient Parade! Many of these kids experienced some of the activities for the first time ever. Again, new friendships were created between patients, and parents were able to connect with other parents of children that have similar experiences.

The camps are a way for Naja to extend our care to patients beyond the hospital walls. Naja is devoted to giving patients the opportunity to participate in activities that build skills and interest in outdoor activities, develop friendships with other patients and their families, and most importantly spend time just being kids with other kids. 

## Cranial Remolding Orthotics now available. Treatment for Plagiocephaly and Torticollis

Plagiocephaly (flat head) and torticollis (wryneck) are conditions that can be diagnosed by a primary family physician or a specialty provider. It is ideal to begin treatment for these conditions around 3-6 months of age.

Patients referred to this clinic will receive a detailed examination by our care team, evaluation will ensure the head deformity is not due to craniosynostosis, which is a condition of fused cranial sutures that may need timely surgical intervention. Each child will receive a customized plan of care determined by our team, which includes Dr. Waleed Gibreel-Cranio facial surgeon, Physician Assistants, Occupational and Physical Therapy, Pediatric Orthotic and Prosthetic Services (POPS).

## **Dr. Waleed Gibreel**

Waleed Gibreel, MBBS, knew as a child that his ultimate goal was to be a doctor, no matter what it took. Growing up in Sudan, Africa, his parents strongly stressed the importance of education for their children and worked very hard to make sure it happened, as education is not free or required for children between ages 6 and 13. In 2009, Dr. Gibreel graduated at the top of his 400-student class with a medical degree.



In 2011, with a dream to become a surgeon at an academic medical center, Dr. Gibreel moved to the United States. Dr. Gibreel's dream became a reality after being accepted into the Mayo Clinic General Surgery Residency Program at Mayo Clinic School of Graduate Medical Education. Dr. Gibreel graduated in May 2019 from the program and completed a one-year fellowship in craniofacial surgery at Children's Hospital of Los Angeles/University of Southern California in August 2020.

Dr. Gibreel's primary practice is at Mayo Clinic in the Division of Plastic Surgery, where he serves as a senior associate consultant and assistant professor of surgery. He joined the team at Shriners Children's Twin Cities in 2022.

Dr. Gibreel's practice includes craniofacial care, pediatric burn reconstruction, and pediatric plastic surgery.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> annual event started with the decorating of the Haunted Walk.


Everyone had fun getting it ready - thanks to all our helpers!

We hope to see you all next year.






