CHRISTMAS AT THE CAPITOL



This year the Shriners of South Dakota were honored to decorate the 30-foot blue spruce in the Capitol rotunda for Christmas on the Capitol's 41st anniversary. With the Shrine celebrating 150 years of our fraternity, and the 100th anniversary of our health care system, the tree's theme focused on the history of the Shrine and healthcare, along with the State's theme of a Merry Prairie Christmas. All three temples from South Dakota, Naja, El Riad, and Yelduz, supplied fezzes that were carefully hung from the tree, including the late governor Mickelson's El Riad Fez. Each temple placed a parade vehicle under the tree to celebrate our long history of community parades, and of course, Fezzy the Bear was hanging in and around the tree.

Naja initially applied to decorate a smaller tree to celebrate our year; however, after a call from the governor's office, Naja and the other temples decided to collaborate and decorate the main State Christmas Tree. The tree was designed by Lady Diana Holloway, and decorated with the help of Ladies Kristi Wagner, Judy Evans, Sherri Fischer, Chris Cole, Julie Evans, Melodee Nelson, and Katie Washnok.

The official lighting was held on November 22nd, and Imperial Sirs Matt Sturlaugson and Tim Forbis, with their Ladies, came for the festivities. The El Riad Chanters provided Christmas music during the lighting, and Governor Kristi Noem spoke to those who attended. 




